## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Yards

EA rules require that yards be of solid construction. Portable yards of solid construction must be secured to a secure object such as a horse truck, float or other substantial object

### Stallions

Please refer to EA Stallion Regulations

### Swabbing

The swabbing of any competition horse/pony may take place on the grounds in a designated veterinary area. All competitors are required to comply with FEI Veterinary Rules and regulations in regards to swabbing.

**Note:** All CAI entries - compulsory FEI swabbing fee of \$24.—per entry will apply.

### Competitor Protective Gear

- Back Protectors – Back Protectors compulsory for all FEI events in Competition B and compulsory for all juniors/children at any time on the carriage, including dressage and cones.
- Helmets – it is compulsory for all competitors to wear protective headgear in Competition B. Current safety standard as recommended by EA. All junior and Children drivers must wear approved protective headgear whenever mounted on a carriage. It is strongly recommended that Athletes and Grooms under the age of 18 years old present at the First Horse Inspection in helmet and back protector.

### Note:

- The Organising Committee reserve the right to:
  - Alter the advertised time
  - Refuse entry, with/without stating reason/s
  - Measure any horse or pony
  - Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class

## FEI Children/Junior/Youth

All drivers must EA Competitor Driving members.

Horses/Ponies must be registered with EA. EA papers required for Horses/Ponies registered with EA prior to 1 January 2017. Horses/Ponies registered after 1 January 2017 require an EA passport.

## Grooms

Grooms must be an EA state member or a member of Oaklands or an EA affiliated club or an event groom member of Oaklands. A membership of Oaklands is available for grooms.

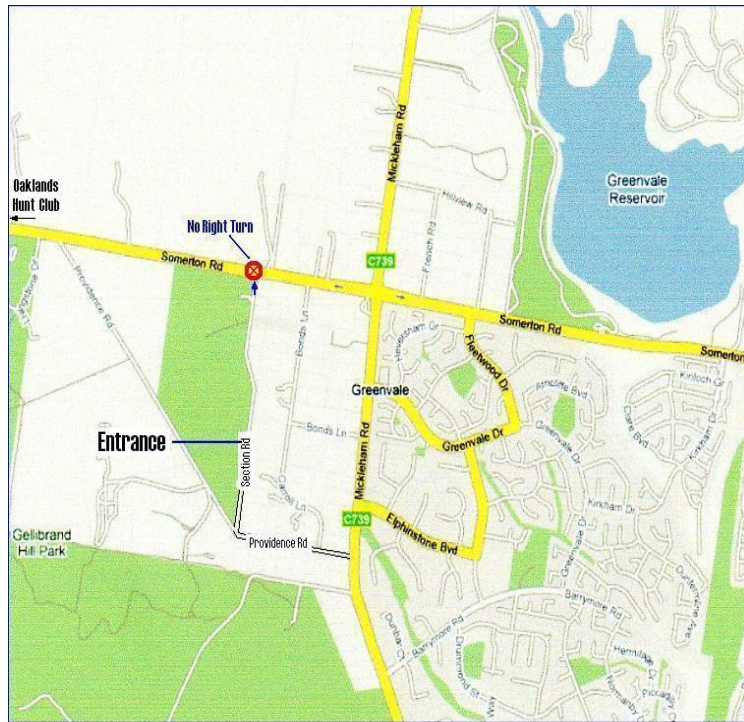

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

<b>Arrival and Departure Date</b>	Arrival at Greenvale is from midday Wednesday 25 April 2018. All competitors must leave the event location by 12 noon on Wednesday 2 May 2018.
<b>Horse/pony registration numbers</b>	<p><b>All</b> horses must be presented at the Horse Inspection and have competition numbers attached to bridle.</p> <p>Horse(s)/pony(s) must display the horse/pony ID number at all times when moving on the grounds (from the time of arrival to the time of departure).</p> <p>If horses not taking part in the official competition are brought to Greenvale, there will be an additional charge of \$20. Permission must be sought from the Event Secretary prior to the event.</p>
<b>Entry fees</b>	Entry fees are non-refundable after the event commences. If a horse or driver is unable to attend due to sickness or accident, an application for refund may be considered by the Organising Committee on production of a medical or veterinary certificate. 20% of entry fees will be retained to cover costs. Requests for refund will not be considered after commencement of the event.
<b>Vet Checks</b>	All horses/ponies to be presented in an open bitted bridle and have their ID number on bridle. Competitors/handlers must be appropriately dressed and must have their competitor number at the vet check.
<b>Dressage</b>	Dressage arena will be open to walk from 9am Friday 27 April 2018. There will be a practice arena available to use from arrival. Dressage times will be provided prior to the event.
<b>Marathon</b>	The course will be 3 sections with a maximum distance of 18 kms and up to 7 obstacles, some of which may be water. The countryside is undulating over paddocks. Section B of the course will be open for inspection from 12 noon on Friday 27 April 2018. Section A and T is closed to motorised vehicles. Competitors will be able to drive motorised vehicles on Section B subject to weather conditions. Section B is not to be inspected before 7am and after 6pm. Obstacles are within close proximity to the clubrooms and camping area. Road laws for Victoria apply. It is the responsibility of the competitor to present themselves at the start of section A 10 minutes before their commencement time.
<b>Cones</b>	The Cones will be driven as a fault competition. Course may contain a bridge and/or water. Cones course will be officially open for

	inspection for 1 ½ hours prior to the first competitor.
<b>Awards</b>	Ribbons awarded to placegetters in each competition. The organisers take no responsibility for the loss of awards and/or prizes if recipients do not remain for the award ceremony at the conclusion of the event.  <b>Competitors are expected to be appropriately dressed for awards ceremony.</b>
<b>Catering</b>	Full canteen available all weekend. Welcome BBQ Friday evening. Spit roast dinner on Saturday evening. Bookings for Saturday evening must be made with your entry. No late bookings will be accepted.
<b>Camping</b>	There are no powered sites. Please make your own arrangements. Generators are to be turned off at 9.30pm and only generators with a quiet motor are allowable.
<b>Showers &amp; Toilets</b>	Showers and toilets available in separate area. The organising committee would request users of the showers to limit time under showers due to the size of the grey water catchment tanks.
<b>Rubbish</b>	Rubbish bins are available.
<b>Accommodation</b>	For those not intending to camp, there are several motels within a 10 minute radius. Please make your own arrangements.
<b>Dogs</b>	Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a leash at all times. You are required to clean up after your dogs.
<b>Local Shops</b>	Closest supermarket and take away food stores etc are 5 minutes away at Greenvale shopping centre.
<b>No Fires</b>	No fires are allowed on the reserve at any time.
<b>Horses/ponies tied to floats/trucks</b>	No horses/ponies are to be tied to floats on marathon day other than when harnessing up. We do not want horses/ponies tied to floats/trucks for several hours after people have packed up.
<b>Helmets</b>	Helmets must comply with the EA rules on helmets.
<b>Kangaroos</b>	Greenvale is home to kangaroos.
<b>Melbourne Airport</b>	For those that wish to visit, Melbourne Tullamarine Airport is 10 minutes from Greenvale Equestrian Reserve.
<b>Tourist Activities</b>	City of Melbourne is about a 20 minute drive.  The adjacent Woodlands Historic Park is the home of Living Legends. A visit will enable you to rub shoulders with a number of Melbourne Cup winners. There is also the old homestead where afternoon tea is served. For those plane enthusiasts, you can sit on the veranda and watch the planes take-off and land.
