



Summary of Business of the meeting of the National Carriage Driving Committee (NCDC) Tuesday 1st March 2016

Election of Chair

Dot Willcoxson was nominated for the position of Chair. No other nominations were received. Dot was unanimously elected the Chair of the NCDC for a 2 year period.

EA & ACDS Relationship

Discussion was held re the opportunity to have EA & the ACDS in a co-operative management of the sport in AUS. A meeting will be arranged so both parties can discuss where the sport of Carriage Driving is moving to in AUS.

Calendar for EA & ACDS Events

The NCDC feel it would be beneficial to coordinate all carriage driving events, both FEI and ACDS, to strengthen the sport & raise the standard of driving in AUS.

Adelaide CAI 4-6 November 2016

Christine Gibbons shared information regarding the CAI in Adelaide on the 4-6 November, with the Dressage and Cones to be held on Friday the 4th and the Marathon on Sunday the 6th November. When available, details will be placed on the EA events calendar.

Establish permanent major event venues within AUS

The NCDC considered the establishment of permanent CAI3* marathon obstacles at 2 or 3 venues in Australia. The NCDC would like to see the standard of our obstacles improve at all events, so our drivers are better prepared for international competition.

Communication

High Performance Program

The High Performance Program is currently undergoing a review with new criteria for squads to be released in the near future.

Education – Officials Accreditation

Discussion points:

- The States run the National training and accreditation pathways
- Running workshops in various states
- Better education of Carriage Driving Judges to better prepare drivers for international competition
- Clinics/seminars to be conducted by International Judges when they are in AUS for FEI events
- Training packages for EA Carriage
