

SELECTION POLICY 2021 WORLD CUP FINAL

This selection policy ('the policy') covers the discipline of Jumping.

1. OBJECTIVE

To select up to two (2) athletes and horses who are able to achieve the best possible results at the 2021 World Cup Final.

2. PROCESS OF SELECTION

Subject to the terms of this policy and any additional FEI qualification/entry requirements:

2.1 On or before **2 March 2021**, the initial process will commence with the Jumping Selection Panel (**the 'JSP'**) receiving Expressions of Interest from which the 2021 World Cup Final individuals will be primarily selected.

2.2 On or before **5th March 2021**, the JSP will select up to two (2) athlete and horse combinations to participate in the 2021 World Cup Final.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION FOR THE WORLD CUP FINAL 2021

3.1 For **Athletes** to be eligible for selection, all athletes must:

3.1.1 Be current members of EA;

3.1.2 Be eligible to compete for Australia as per FEI regulations Art. 119;

3.2 For **Horses** to be eligible for selection to World Cup Final Nominated Entries, all horses must:

3.2.1 be registered with EA or should the horse be permanently domiciled in a country other than Australia, a current FEI passport administered by either EA or the rider's host country;

3.2.3 have a current FEI passport

4. NOMINATION CRITERIA

The nomination criteria combines the FEI qualification requirements, and the General criteria.

4.1 General Criteria

4.1.1 Australian based athletes past performances in World Cup competitions will be taken into consideration.

4.1.2 Overseas based athletes past performances in World Cup Qualifiers and CSI3* and above competitions will be taken into consideration.

4.1.3 Final selection will be at the sole discretion of the National Selection Panel – Jumping.
