EA Steward General Position Description

Overview

EA Sport Committees are generally responsible for the overall management of the training and accreditation of officials within their Discipline. This responsibility is delegated to them by the National Board.

The EA Stewarding accreditation program is an EA Officiating responsibility that goes across all Disciplines and is facilitated by the EA National Office.

The FEI has appointed Stewards General for each of its Disciplines (Sports) and expects its member National Federations (NFs) to adopt a similar system.

The NF Discipline Steward General is proposed to the FEI by his NF and is responsible for stewarding at international events within his NF. Prior to appointment as Discipline Steward General they must hold at least **FEI Level 2 Steward** status and must have good knowledge of English. In addition, he is required to report to the FEI Regional Steward General with suggestions for improvement relating to stewarding matters.

Please note: The EA National Office will liaise direct with the AERA (Endurance) and the Reining Australia regarding the FEI Steward requirements within these organisations.

Specific Functions and Responsibilities

According to the FEI "Education System for FEI Stewards (12.12.2012)", the duties of the NF Discipline Steward General are:

- To act as the contact person between his/her NF and the FEI Regional Steward General and if necessary directly with the FEI Honorary Steward General in matters relating to stewarding within the discipline;
- To advise his NF on all matters relating to his/her responsibility;
- To be familiar with the organisation of an international event;
- To have a good knowledge of the discipline rules, veterinary matters, FEI Veterinary Regulations and the FEI legal system;
- To inform the OCs of international events in his/her country of their responsibilities relating to
- The FEI Discipline Steward General must arrange for FEI Levels 1 and 2 Steward Courses to be organized within their NF.

Skills

Stewards General must demonstrate the following:

- An excellent understanding of their respective sports, their rules and their operation, in particular in regard to
 events
- A high level of knowledge and understanding of Stewarding requirements for the respective EA sports.
- Experience with the delivery of courses (presentation skills)*.
- Experience with the application of assessment procedures*.
- An ability to provide leadership.
- An ability to handle conflict and manage change.

- An ability to work as part of a team and also to exercise initiative when required.
- Good organisational and administrative skills.
- Good communication skills, both written and oral.
- Ability to use email communication
 - ** Certificate IV Workplace Trainer and Assessor will be highly regarded.

Personal Attributes

- High degree of personal and professional integrity.
- A commitment to follow the principles promoted in the EA Officials' Code of Conduct.
- Tact and diplomacy balanced with the capacity to make decisions.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Capacity to engender respect from and work with riders, officials, owners, Organising Committees and others involved in the sport.
- Ability to copy with numerous tasks simultaneously and to respond appropriately in stressful situations.

Allowances & Reimbursements

These are volunteer positions. EA will reimburse out-of-pocket expenses directly related to carrying out the functions at FEI Stewards education courses.

Special Requirements

Stewards General must be available to travel, both within Australia and overseas if required to attend FEI or International Courses. This may involve substantial periods of time away from home.

Stewards General must be able to be contacted by telephone and e-mail, with an ability to respond promptly and appropriately to communication from the Chairs of the National Sport Committees, the CEO, the National Officials Officer and EA Branch staff.

Key Performance Indicators

Appointments are for a 4-year period linked to the Olympic cycle*. A committee consisting of the General Manger - Sports, the Pathways Officer – Officials and a member of corresponding National Sport Committee will review the performance of all Stewards General. Reviews are performed separately for each Steward General.

The review will be guided by some or all of the following criteria, as agreed with the respective Steward General at the time of the appointment:

- The general effectiveness of stewarding arrangements at International events organised in their respective sports in Australia.
- Number of accredited EA Stewards under the EA Accreditation program.
- Number of EA/FEI courses facilitated/delivered in alignment with EA National Office
- Number of EA Members newly accredited under the FEI Stewards accreditation program.
- Number of appointments as FEI Steward at major events, also considering the level of events
- Supply of written articles and information for dissemination within the EA Community.
- Participation in and commitment to an on-going program review process.
- Satisfaction of the relevant EA National Sport Committee.

The CEO or a National Board Member may initiate a performance review at any time.

*Due to COVID-19 the previous cycle was extended for 1 year to minimise disruption and this period will be shortened for 1 year to align back into the Olympic cycle
