

Equestrian Australia Dressage Committee - UPDATE

Meeting held on Thursday 25th May 2020 Below is a summary of proceedings at the recent EADC meeting

MEETING DISCUSSION

The meeting discussed a proposal from the EA Dressage Judge Committee (EADJC) in relation to the Tutoring and Mentoring of Judges.

The Committee agreed in principal with the EADJC. To align more closely with FEI criteria, the use of Judge Educators for A & B Level Judges for one (1) sit-in session will be allowed. C Level and below Judges will remain with the current system which utilises Judge Mentors. Note: Judge Educators can be used but are not mandatory.

The Committee continue to address the viability of holding the 2020 Australian Dressage championships in the current climate. The most current statement can be found at:
