

Equestrian Australia Driving Committee - UPDATE

Meeting held: 3 April 2023
Below is a summary of proceedings at the recent EA Driving Committee meeting

MEETING DISCUSSION

Backstepper Competency

FEI Driving Rules - 'The NF must ensure that the Groom must be knowledgeable and experienced in Driving'

EA Driving Rules - 'As for the Athlete, the Navigator/Backstepper must also have achieved the level of competence required to result in safe, harmonious event participation. Coaching and training of the Navigator/Backstepper is just as important as the coaching and training of the Athlete.

To assist with acknowledging Backstepper competencies, the EA Driving Committee are developing a certification (education resource and quiz) for Backsteppers to be introduced over the next 6-12 months.

Official's Pathways

Continued work on development of the Officials Courses. Aiming for a refresher course to be run in August 2023.

Para-Equestrian

Discussion around para-equestrian including pathways, equity classes and driver classifying. Driving Para-Equestrian rules to be reviewed as part of mid-year rule review. Also, discussions regarding a Disability Driving Pathway for clubs where no classification is required.
