Equestrian Australia Endurance Committee -UPDATE

Meeting held: 23rd June 2020 Below is a summary of proceedings at the recent EAEC meeting

MEETING DISCUSSION

Opening and Welcome:

Chair thanked all members for their attendance.

Naomi O'Shaughnessy attended her first meeting as the newly appointed Athletes Representative and a special welcome from all was extended. The Chair addressed the quality of applicants received for this position and stated he is very excited to have on board someone with the International competition experience Naomi brings to the Committee.

EA in Voluntary Administration

Since the 9 June announcement, the Chair had attended two National Discipline Committee & Coach Committee (NDC&CC) Chairs meeting with the EA Directors. Endurance felt the impact of the high cost to both run and participate in a FEI ride. Options on the future direction of EA and impacts was discussed in detail. The Committee agreed:

Team Camp 2020

Whilst plans for the Bullio Mater Cup ride were underway, the Team Camp required input from a dedicated coordinating group.

- A range of topics/speakers planned
- Timetable developed.

Trans-Tasman 2021

Two potential events were targeted. Whilst the event was still over twelve months off, a timeline has been instigated to ensure horses have adequate time to prepare as a pool of loan horses ($8 \times 2^*$) will be required.

Regional Championship 2023

The vision for this event is to allow members the opportunity to have an International experience without the costs normally associated with competing overseas. Chair has attended a meeting with Chris Webb, EA High Performance Manager, and members of the HP Team to discuss the concept and potential areas that may be problematic as a host. It is anticipated that the event will be attractive to all members of Group 8.

Endurance Pathway – Grassroots to FEI

The concept for this document is to provide the Novice or new rider a range of targets to achieve their best by understanding the planning required to progress through the levels. The first draft of this document has been completed. The second draft will focus on the Elite level.
