## **Equestrian Australia Jumping Committee - UPDATE**

Below a summary of proceedings at the recent EAJC Committee meeting:

## **MEETING DISCUSSION**

## **Opening and Welcome:**

Chair welcomed all the attendees and thanked them for their valuable time.

The meeting discussed Data Collection requirements and will further explore the option of the athlete indicating their primary and secondary sport discipline interest and the reporting on this data to allow for future planning of the sport from grassroots to elite level.

EA National Jumping Rules (effective 1 January 2021) will be published on the EA website following ratification by EA Board (Korda Mentha during Voluntary Administration period).

The Draft National Jumping Calendar is being collated with a deadline of October for submission by the States and should include (as a minimum):

- 1. World Cup Events
- 2. Royal Shows
- 3. State Championships
- 4. 3 Young Rider Series nominated events
- 5. **PLUS** 10 events that will make up the events for Rider Ranking Points.

Competitors are reminded that Passports for FEI competition should be organised a minimum of 21 days prior to competition. An FAQ document will be developed with this and other requirements for FEI competition and will be sent to OCs for inclusion in schedules as well as promoted on the EA website and social media.
