



Equestrian Australia Jumping Committee - UPDATE

Meeting held 11 August 2020

Below a summary of proceedings at the recent EAJC Committee meeting:

MEETING DISCUSSION

Opening and Welcome:

Chair welcomed all the attendees and thanked all attending for their time.

Discussion of 2021 Rule Changes

The meeting received the proposed rule changes from EA Judges Committee Reference Group. They were discussed and will be consolidated for further review and ratification at the next meeting,

Jumping Competition Licence

The Committee discussed the proposal for a digital/electronic format. The Committee agreed that the concept had merit and agreed to continue to work for a solution.

2020-2021 Australian FEI Jumping World Cup™ Season

It was agreed that the Committee would ask the FEI to confirm:

- Whether a 'wild card' entry would be available for the final scheduled in Gothenburg 31 March-5 April 2021 due to lack of events in Australia in the current season due to COVID-19
- Inclusion of the Australian League Rules as an Annex in the FEI World Cup™ Rules
- Exemption request for DJWTS World Cup which is due to run during the World Cup Final exclusion period

FEI 2021 Calendar

Applications are being received and will be reviewed and approved at the next meeting.

EA Online database

Discussion on requirements for an API to allow upload of results by other providers was noted and will be passed to the Requirements team. OCs are reminded that they can send copies of results to their State Office for them to be manually uploaded.

Australian Jumping Championships

No decision by the OC. EAJC confirmed that all borders must be open to allow the event to run.
