Equestrian Australia Jumping Committee - UPDATE

Meeting held: 16 JULY 2020

Below is a summary of proceedings at the recent EAJC meeting

MEETING DISCUSSION

Opening and Welcome:

Chair welcomed all the attendees and thanked them for their valuable time, apologies received from the Athletes Representative. This meeting was called specifically to discuss Event Calendar, World Cup and Australian Championships for the remainder of 2020.

World Cup:

The EAJC acknowledge financial burden on the OC currently with a lack of sponsorship dollars due to the current economic climate and the rise in venue costs. The uncertainty around travel restrictions added to this. The EAJC were unanimous that all Borders must be open for a World Cup event to be staged.

The Committee continue to work with the OC of the five remaining scheduled events due to occur in September, November, December, and January, and support any decision the OC make in relation to hosting World Cup classes.

Australian Championships:

The EAJC consider horse welfare (fitness) high on the consideration list for planning of this event. Riders must have good notice to plan for this event, which will leave the OC a short window of opportunity to confirm this event will go ahead. Again, the Borders must be open for all for this event to take place. The Committee is working with the Boneo OC as they consider their options for the event to go ahead.

Should the 2020 event be cancelled, Boneo have been offered the right to host the 2021 event should they wish.
