Meeting held 2 June 2020

Below a summary of proceedings at the recent EAJC Committee meeting:

MEETING DISCUSSION

Calendar for 2020-2021

The Committee have generated a calendar of events to be shared publicly in the next few weeks. The effect of COVID-19 on Organising Committees was creating havoc with scheduling and the Committee were working closely with State Jumping Committees to monitor this. Opening of State borders was pivotal to the ability to run events like the Australian Championships and World Cups.

Australian Championships – Inclusion of Technical Delegate

This proposal has been taken to final document stage with the delivery of the TD Role and Responsibilities incorporating EA Pre and Post Reporting and addresses the inclusion of a TD at Australian Championships. The Committee encourage the use of a TD at State Championships.

World Cup Season

Correspondence continues with the FEI on the five events scheduled for the remainder of the 2020 season, the impact to Australian based riders on meeting COC requirements and Event quarantine dates in relation to Tokyo21.

EA Board Discussion with NDC and Coach Committee members invited – 27.5.20

The Committee will continue to discuss the points raised during this meeting in relation to restructure and are happy to have an active voice representing Jumping on this topic.
