



# MEETING SUMMARY

## EQUESTRIAN AUSTRALIA

### JUMPING COMMITTEE

Teleconference 18 May 2017

- All communications from EAJC to be approved by committee before distribution
- Reintroduction of 'upgrading/downgrading' facility: To be referred to Judges Reference Group.
- Compression suit: The Judges' Reference Group determined that the compression suit is not allowed in competition.
- Judges Curriculum.: Future applications for upgrading to EA Level 3 require State Branches to provide the exam results in addition to the published criteria to the EAJC
- Imported Horses: Some states are issuing performance cards before imported horses are assessed which is not allowed. Riders are requesting reassessment after horses have begun competing which precludes them from being assessed. There is a need to have the horse registration form updated to make it clear that imported horses need to be assessed if they wish to have the points allocated as per the rules reviewed.
- Young Horse Classes: The EAJC will review whether points will be allocated for placing in these competitions.
- Budget: A budget for the operation of the EAJC has been developed and will be submitted to the Board of EA
- Expression of Interest for Australian Show Jumping Championships. This will be posted on the EA website.
- Four Year Plan: The EAJC will begin work on preparing a 4 year plan for the sport.
- Jumping Triple Crown: This initiative of the EA will be conducted at the ASJC, Showcase of Show Jumping WC, and the Adelaide International 3DE WC.
- Stewards' Reference Group. David Willis be invited to be a member of the group.
- Young Rider Series: Conditions are posted on EA website. South Australia has conducted the first completion for their state.
- EAJC Riders Representative: State RR will elect an interim representative to the committee. Annual meeting for RR to be conducted at ASJC.
- National Selectors. EAJC recommendation to the EA High Performance panel discussed and submitted
