

### EA Vaulting Committee Update June 2018

The EAVC would like to give our members an update on what has been happening with the EAVC.

- The EOI for the position on the EAVC has been posted by EA and is in the process of being finalised. We hope to advise you all soon who this new member will be.
- WEG long list has been announced by the Selectors and has been posted by the EA. The EAVC wishes to congratulate all who have been nominated and wish them success in their plans and goals for WEG. We would also like to announce that Tristyn Lowe has been appointed by the EA HP Manager as Chef for the WEG team. We know that Tristyn will do a wonderful job for all of our vaulters, as she brings so much knowledge and experience to help all the vaulters achieve the best outcomes from their WEG experience.
- Two working groups have been formed by the EVCA to address concerns raised
  - Results/Data Group coordinated by Lisbeth Betts will look at coming up with a solution to developing a central results data base with EA, where all results from official competitions held in Australia will be maintained and easily assessed by all members. From this database we are looking at developing a National Leader board for our Australian Vaulters. More details to come soon.
  - Club Insurance Group coordinated by Tony Richardson will look at concerns about club insurance offered by EA and Gow Gates. They will work with EA and Gow Gates to try to see if it is possible to come up with a solution that will fit the vaulting clubs better. Please contact Tony Richardson if you have any concerns or questions.
- The National Championships will be hosted by the OC of combined SVG/SHVG at K Ranch (NSW). The National Schedule will be finalised and approved within the next week and should be made public by the OC soon
- The new updated Australian Vaulting Rules will come into force in July, so please note any changes. You can access them on the EA website.
- The EAVC is hoping, with the permission from the OC of the National Championships, to have a meeting with the Vaulting Chairs from the States to start to develop a coordinated strategic plan to develop our sport looking at Athletes, Coaches, Officials and horses. So if you have any ideas or suggestion please contact your State committees so that they can bring them to the table at this meeting.
- The EA Vaulting page has been updated. Please note the changes for OC's running competitions. They are to contact the Scorers Group for Score sheets and scoring systems for their competition. This is only a temporary step as the judging system from the FEI that we follow has changed so much. We ask that all members have patience as we work with the Judges Group, Scorers Group and EA to update all Australian systems and score sheets.
- The EAVC is looking to facilitate a coaches' forum similar to the judges' forum as a way for the coaches to come together and share experiences and knowledge in the most cost efficient way.

This way improving the core knowledge and skill of all of our coaches, and assisting our vaulters to develop and improve. More information coming soon.
