

### JUDGE ACCREDITATION <u>1 JANUARY 2018 – 31 MARCH 2022</u> <u>COMPULSORY REQUIREMENTS</u>



# The following forms are required to be completed in order to maintain your judge accreditation through to 31/3/25

### NOTE:

- Rule 12.9 refers to the requirements to remain accredited
- Please note that this re-accreditation period covers 4 years\*. e.g. 1/1/18 to 31/03/2022
- Judges who have not met the compulsory requirements may have their accreditation extended for a period of time in order to meet the requirements
- If you have not completed all the prerequisites for re-accreditation, please refer to rule 12.8.1g

\*The usual 3 year period has been extended by 12 months due to COVID 19. During this current reaccreditation period you need to have completed the following:

### Seminars

- G to A must attend at your level. However, to <u>maintain accreditation</u> G level judges may attend any seminar that includes F level and F level judges may attend any seminar that includes G level
- Young Horse Judges must attend a YH seminar
- Para Dressage Judges- must attend a PD seminar
- Only seminars approved by the State JSC or EADOC will be recognised

### Workshops

- Must attend at least 2 these are considered professional development and educational activities and make you a better Judge. Additional seminars may be substituted
- Only workshops approved by the State JSC or EADOC will be recognised
- Judging All levels due to COVID restrictions resulting in a number of events being cancelled or unable to be held, as long as you have judged at least 6 <u>competitions</u>, with a minimum of two of these at your highest level e.g. if D level judge then your highest level is Medium competitions, you will be considered as having met the judging requirement for the current re-accreditation period. For G levels this may include Eventing dressage.
  - **YH** judges will not be required to have judged one YH competition in this reaccreditation period

#### **EA PROHIBITED PERSON DECLARATION – EA Officials**

EA and its affiliated organisations have a duty of care to their members and to the general public who interact with EA Officials, as these responsibilities may involve direct and/or unsupervised contact with people under the age of 18 years. - 1. I do not have any criminal charge pending before the courts, nor any criminal convictions or findings of guilt for offences involving drugs, acts of violence, sexual activity, acts of indecency, child abuse or child pornography.
- 2. I have not had any disciplinary proceedings brought against me by an employer, sporting organisation or similar body involving child abuse, sexual misconduct or harassment, acts of violence, intimidation or other forms of harassment.
- 3. I have never been sanctioned for an anti-doping rule violation under any EA anti-doping policy (Athlete or Equine).
- 4. I have never participated in, facilitated or encouraged any practice prohibited by the World Anti-Doping Agency Code or any other anti-doping policy applicable to me, in the EA Horse Anti-Doping Policy.
- 5. To my knowledge there is no other matter that EA may consider to constitute a risk to its members, employees, volunteers, athletes or reputation by accepting my EA Official registration.
- 6. I will notify the CEO of the organisation(s) engaging me immediately upon becoming aware that any of the matters set out in clauses [1 to 5] above has changed for whatever reason.
