The following are proposed Eventing rule changes to become effective immediately (safety)

520.4	<b>EA Minimum Eligibility Requirements</b>	Clarification of current rule	<p><b>520.4 Short Format CNC</b></p> <p><i>For 105 if a rider has 15 MER's at the level over a rolling 8 year period then this deems the rider established.</i></p> <p><i>For a horse and rider to start at 105 they must have 3 qualifying results in official EVA 95 (or grade 2 Pony Club competition or <b>NSW B Grade Pony Club</b>). One of these results may not have more that 20 Cross Country jumping faults. The other 2 must be clear of Cross Country faults <b>and at least 1 of these must be at an official EA competition. Unless the rider is categorised at 105 or above.</b></i></p>
