



FEI Children's International Jumping Classic 2017

Article 1 Principles

1. The FEI Children's International Classics may be organised by any member NF of the FEI.

2. There are three tours, Gold, Silver and Bronze, of different standards. Children may participate in qualifying events with horses or ponies in all three tours. Athletes may only compete on horses in the Final.

3. Each tour consists of 2 competitions run over different courses designed by a Course Designer designated by the FEI.

4. Each of the two competitions consists of 2 rounds run under Table A. In case of equality of penalties after the second round of either competition, the time of the second round will decide. Both rounds must be jumped on the same day.

5. The complete competition consists of four rounds. The final score for each athlete is the total penalties of the four rounds and the total of his/her time in the two second rounds. If the totals of times are equal, the fastest time in the second round of the second competition will decide.

6. Gold Tour competitions must be organised at outdoor Events between 1 January and 9 October 2017. Silver and Bronze Tour competitions must be organised at outdoor Events between 1 January and 4 December 2017.

7. Horses must be at least six years old.
