Strategic Aims

- Provide a platform for Generation Next Show Jumping athletes to be exposed to international training and competition to further abilities as an athlete aiming to competing at a future Olympics and/or World Games.
- Provide an educational program, highlighting Equestrian (Jumping) as a sport within the framework of the Australian Sports Commission, Australian Institute of Sport, in pursuit of medal attainment aligned against provision of funding.
- Create an opportunity for athletes to integrate with the AIS and support initiatives for world best athlete practice. i.e. Sport Science Sports Medicine Program (SSSM), Veterinary Program, EA Education options, Media and the athlete, Best Coaches, Sports Psychology in pursuit of best team culture.
- Create an opportunity for athletes to integrate into the international training and competition arena.
- Use knowledge of athletes and personal coaches to provide performance management of the best athletes at key transition stages in their career
- Provide meaningful opportunities for HPJP staff and Generation Next Panel to interact with selected athletes and their personal coaches in order to assess their potential to contribute to the overall program aims in a given cycle.
- Improve athletes' and personal coaches' understanding of High Performance issues and major championships planning.
- Create a working relationship with athletes and personal coaches via regular contact and work towards achieving short and long term goals
- Provide recognition and status for the nation's best Generation Next athletes and their personal coaches
