KNOW YOUR EA COACHING COMMITTEE

EA COACH INSURANCE

As an EA affiliated coach, you have access to the EA National Insurance Programme, which offers 24/7 Personal Accident, Public Liability and Professional Indemnity Insurance whilst engaged in coaching activities (within the scope of your accreditation). If you coach beyond your EA accreditation, train or compete clients' horses or run an agistment property, please contact Marsh Sport to make sure you have the appropriate cover for your business.

NEW COACH INDEMNITY WAIVER FORMS

To access the new COACHING PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RISK WARNING, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY (AGREEMENT) waiver form click on the following link

This form is a writable pdf so there is no need to print it out for each client – they can read the form online, sign it electronically, save a copy and send you a copy for your records.

The form is to be used for all clients - both EA and non-EA members.

It is the responsibility of the individual coach to ensure that any waivers or declarations meet the individual circumstances in which they operate.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Here you will find concussion training information and webinar dates along with all your concussion reporting needs and protocols.

There are two specific reporting requirements:

A) No apparent injury/illness (Inc near misses) EA-HSMS-MED-Incident Referral-Report Form 08 is to be completed for any person who nearly had an accident, a fall or incident. Even if they present with no apparent injury or illness and/or require basic treatment e.g. band aid

B) ALL Serious Incidents (SI) (ambulance transfer, unable to continue lesson, a suspected concussion or other) EA-HSMS-MED-Incident Referral-Report Form 08 MUST be completed as soon as able within 24hrs of the SI.

Anytime Form 08 is completed, a copy should be sent to <u>reporting@equestrian.org.au</u> and your insurance company. For EA coaches insured with the EA scheme, this is Marsh – <u>sport@marsh.com</u>. All coaches should consider the completion of Form 08 as a potential insurance claim. It is in your best interest to cooperate with your insurance company if they need to undertake any further investigation. They are working FOR YOU!

CONCUSSION TRAINING

It will be a mandatory requirement the coach registration for 22/23 that all coaches must have attended concussion training webinar.

EQ, ENT AND EWA MEMBERSHIP STATUS AND COACHING ACCREDITATION

CE/SSTA UPDATES

127 EA Coach Educators and EA Skill Specific Trainer/Assessors recently attended their Update workshops which are required every 2 years.
