#### NOTE:

- Rule 12.9 refers to the requirements to remain NOAS accredited
- Please note that the re-accreditation period covers 3 full years e.g. 1/1/18 to 31/12/20
- The reaccreditation process will take place in February/March 2021 and will close on 31/3/21
- Judges who have not re-accredited by 31/3/21 will automatically drop off the judges list from 1/4/21
- Judges who have not met the compulsory requirements may have their accreditation extended for a period of time in order to meet the requirements
- Judges who, after a period of extension, still do not meet the requirements will be downgraded at least 1 level

### Compulsory Seminar – you must make sure that your attendance is recorded on the attendance sheet:

- **G to A** must attend at your level at least every 3 years. However, to <u>maintain accreditation</u> G level judges may attend any F seminar and F level judges may attend any G seminar
- Young Horse Judges must attend a YH seminar every 3 years
- Para Dressage Judges- must attend a PD seminar every 3 years
- Only seminars approved by the JSC or EADJC will be recognised

## Compulsory Workshops - you must make sure that your attendance is recorded on the attendance sheet

- Must attend at least 2 within the 3 year period on an annual basis i.e. a workshop or seminar each year these
  are considered professional development and educational activities and make you a better Judge. Additional
  seminars may be substituted
- Only workshops approved by the JSC or EADJC will be recognised

# Judging - Official Competitive competitions - F to A

• You are required to judge 6 Official Competitive competitions at your judging level i.e:

F at Novice	E at Elementary	D at Medium
C at Advanced	B at PSG or Inter I	A at Inter A to GP

**Note** – if you have upgraded during the re-accreditation period please note this and this will be taken into consideration on a pro rata basis when assessing what you have judged at your highest level.

Young Horse Judges – Must have judged at least 1 YH competition

# Judging - Other competitions - F to A

• F to A judges - You are required to judge 6 other <u>competitions</u> at any level up to your highest level e.g. Official, Participation, AHRC, Eventing, restricted etc

#### Judging - G Level Judges

 You are required to judge at 6 <u>competitions</u> – Official Prelim or Participation/Club at Prelim/Novice level this can include Eventing dressage





#### Open Rule Book Tests (ORBT)

All will be available from approx. mid February 2021 (to be completed by 31/3/21) and can be completed online
or a copy can be sent to you on request. All judges will be advised when the ORBT is available

If you keep this diary up to date as you do 'things' then this will make life much easier for you at re-accreditation time when all that will need to be sent in will be:

- the EA Re-accreditation Form which must be signed and indicate your intentions to either re-new, seek leave of absence (LOA) or resign
- your ORBT certificate/s if done online
- and this completed diary (no need to send in attendance certificates or results sheets)

Seminar and workshop attendances are recorded nationally by the Secretary EADJC. It is important that you make sure that you have signed in and you are actually recorded on the attendance list. If you claim a seminar or workshop that is not recorded then you will be asked to produce the attendance certificate so it is important that you keep your attendance certificates.
