

L1HM ASSESSMENT SLIP 6 – Travelling

If the travel plan is not suitable, the candidate may re-present the amended plan to the Coach Educator one week later with notes outlining reasons behind the changes

Note: The practical component may be demonstrated at the end of a session when the candidate is ready to go home if this suits the horse best. Horses that are difficult to load may be substituted for other horses for the purpose of this assessment.

When a horse proves difficult to load and cannot be substituted, a favourable view shall be taken of a candidate's ability to deal with problems in a calm, safe manner demonstrating sensible training methods.
