Presenters:

Presenters are those endorsed by the EAJC after, in either order, submitting an EOI form and attending a Train the Trainer Day conducted by EAJC'S representative.

Role of the Presenters:

Presenters are to have a sound a current understanding of Course Design, be a minimum EA Level 3 Course Designer and have a proven background in the sport. They must have knowledge of the Course Designer Syllabus from Level 1 to Level 3 depending on their accreditation and the assessment tools used to assess candidates.

At Conclusion of Level 1nd 2 Clinics:

Presenters are to supervise the written examinations, provide assessment and confidential feedback to participants.

Send a clinic Summary report to the relevant State Branch of EA with the names of the participants who have successfully passed the theory examination for consideration for promotion.

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At conclusion of Level 3 Clinic:

Presenters are to supervise the written examinations, provide assessment and confidential feedback to participants.

Send a clinic Summary report to the EAJC with the names of the participants who have successfully passed the theory examination. The EAJC will then consider the practical experience requirements for any upgrades.
