Lapsed Official An Official is considered lapsed if they have not been accredited for more than 12 months. Officials may re-accredit and return to the list by</p> <p>6.1 Lapsed Less than Three years Officials who have been absent from the EA Jumping Officials list for less than 3 years must</p> <p>6.1.1 Be a current member of Equestrian Australia, and if necessary, the relevant State jumping council or sub-committee and accredited by that organization</p> <p>6.1.2 Attend and pass an EA Jumping Officials refresher course.</p> <p>6.2 Lapsed for Three or more years Officials who have been absent from the EA Jumping Officials list for more than 3 years must</p> <p>6.2.1 Be a current member of Equestrian Australia, and if necessary, the relevant State jumping council or sub-committee and accredited by that organization</p> <p>6.2.2 Attend and pass an EA Jumping Officials course at in their previous appointed level</p> <p>6.2.3 will be required to complete and pass all the requirements for their previous level before being returned to the list</p>
