


Scoreboard App


The app is called Nominate Scoreboard and can be downloaded from Google Play or the Apple app store.


It works on phones and tablets.

Users get the option to sign in as a competitor, or as a visitor. It is important that you allow notifications so that you get messages sent by the event organisers as well as your results.




If you are a competitor, you can sign in using your Nominate rider login details, or you can log in using your surname and booking reference (which is on the entry receipt)






When you sign in, the events that you have entered display under "My Events"

You can also search for events that you are interested in but haven't entered or click on the calendar on the top right and look at events on a particular date, or you can click on "All Events" at the bottom of the screen.




When you select an event on this page, it takes you to the event home page, with options to see the schedule, class information etc.








The buttons at the bottom of the screen do pretty much what they say on the lables.
