

SCORING FOR VAULTING COMPETITIONS

Scores for vaulting are achieved by Judges considering a variety of criteria, recording scores out of 10 and then the scorers process the Judges scores through a number of complex calculations to achieve a final score out of 10. As vaulting is an “ever evolving” sport it is challenging to have a perfect scoring system which adapts quickly to Rule changes and changes in Judging and scoring approaches.

From 1/1/2017 a Group of volunteers experienced in Vaulting scoring and skilled with database manipulations and calculations have been working to adapt to the changes resulting from the options to run competition with anywhere from 1 to 4 judges. An additional challenge in Australian Vaulting is that we have a developmental structure in our competition classes, so one size rarely fits all; add to that the developments in the FEI Judging and scoring systems and we have reached a point where scoring systems need to be tailor made for competitions. A streamlined system was in trial, but the new variables have resulted in too much complexity for it to be easily used by OC's. Equestrian Australia is keen to have a consistent scoring and results system across all disciplines.

So from 1/1/2018, Please prepare your schedules in accord with the class numbers below. Competition organisers need to approach the group on ausvaulting.scorers@gmail.com as soon as your schedules are published and we will allocate a Vaulting Scorer from this group to prepare your score sheets and your scoring systems for you. Once you have completed your draw, you need to forward it (as an excel spreadsheet) to your nominated “ausscorer” who will prepare both the scores sheets and the scoring system for your competition. These will be returned to you for printing (pdf files) and the scoring system will be forwarded as an excel spreadsheet. You will need a volunteer who has some excel skills to complete the scoring at your competition. Most OC's will also have a printer on-site to publish provisional final scores. ausscorers are working with Nominate to produce consistent reporting of final scores for all competitions.

Each class number may have a further descriptor in the following orders:

- XC – Compulsories only
- XF – Freestyle only
- F – Female
- M- Male
- S- Senior
- J- Junior
- R1- Round 1
- R2 – Round 2
- D – AWD
