5.6.3	Resident in the State	For clarification and avoidance of doubt	Resident in the State – applies to interstate horses changing ownership (including where appropriate within a 100km radius of a border) – must be registered and/or transferred 3-months and 1 day 90 days before their state HOTY. Northern Territory to be exempt from 90 day 3-month and 1 day residency rule.
