## Rider Representative Role and Responsibilities

Role and responsibilities of the Australian League World Cup Jumping Riders Representative to the FEI World Cup Committee of the Australian League for the period 2016-2018.

The main responsibilities of the Riders Representative are:

- At the CSI-W approach the organising committee and let them know that you are on site and available if there are any issues regarding the CSI-W.
- Make sure the CSI-W nominated riders know that you are the riders representative for that class and you will deal with any OC issues on their behalf.
- Observe and make sure correct and safe equipment is used on course and in the warm up.
- Walk the course and be on hand to handle any rider issues.
- Make sure there is an appointed FEI steward at the warm up arena.
- Following the CSI-W complete the 'Riders Representative's' report which reports on the venue, program, footing, equipment, course design, organising committee, warm up area, and room for any additional comments.
- If you are not the Riders Representative, you must collect the Riders Report from the representing rider.

The skills and knowledge required for the role:

- High Level Competition Experience
- Solid understanding of the FEI and EA World Cup rules.
